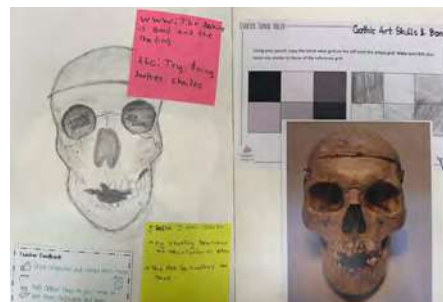
This year at Dubai Heights Academy, the Art Department has nurtured creativity and technical skill across all key stages.

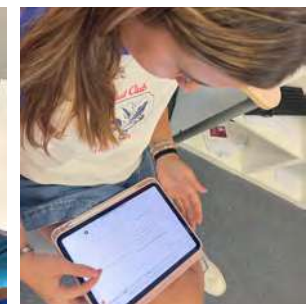
It has been a successful year in the Computer Science department, with students across all year groups showing great enthusiasm and progress.

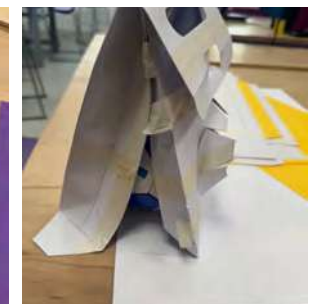

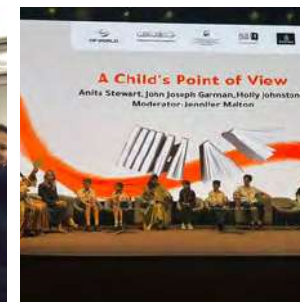
We've had a lot of fantastic events and opportunities to develop our English language skills this year at Dubai Heights Academy.

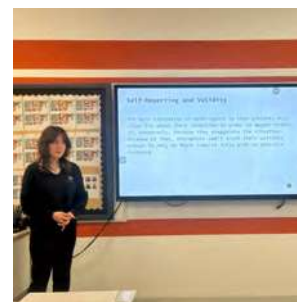
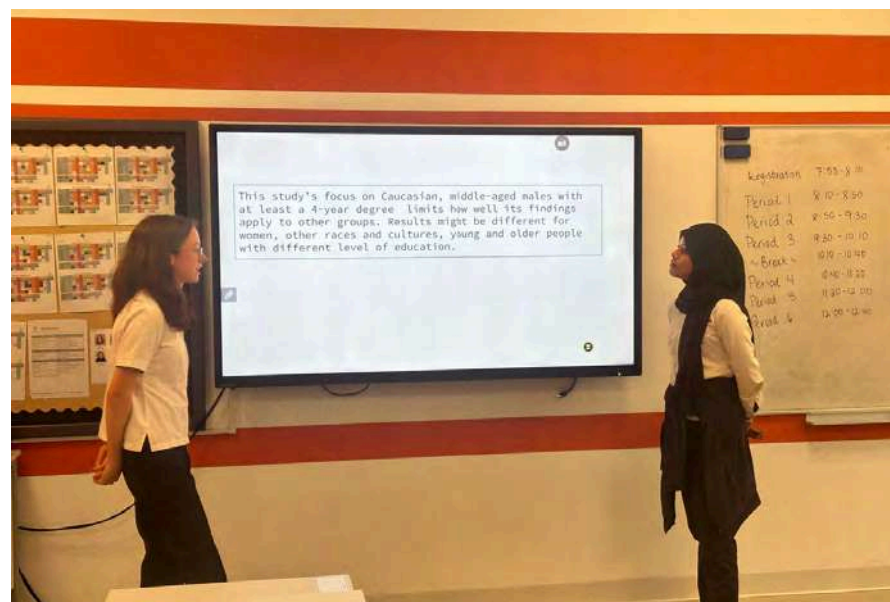
# PSYCHOLOGY

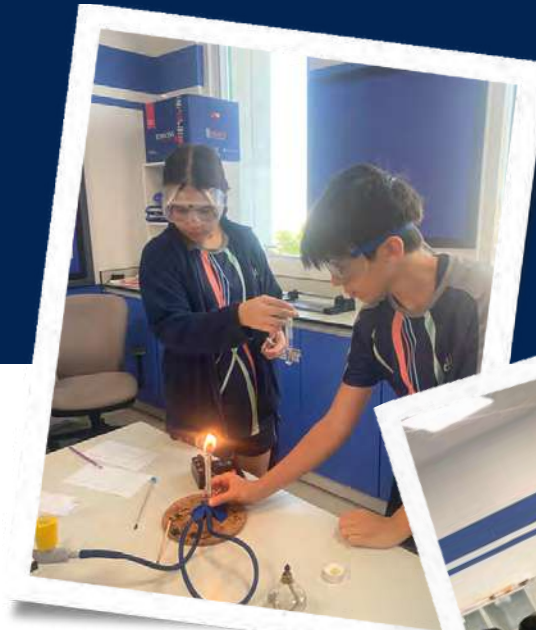




# SCIENCE: SECONDARY

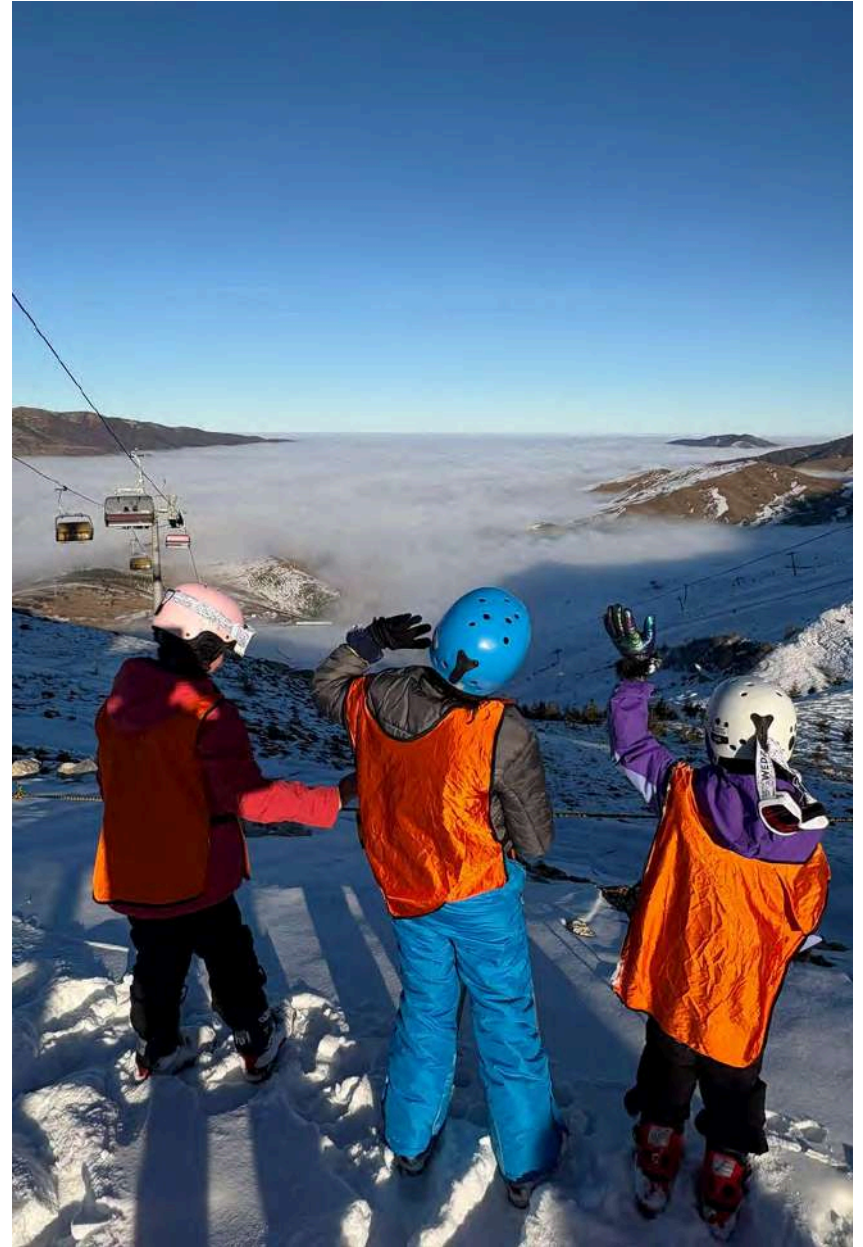

In addition to the challenges our More Able, Gifted and Talented pupils have received in class, they have also participated in bespoke ECAs and external competitions against students from across the UAE.

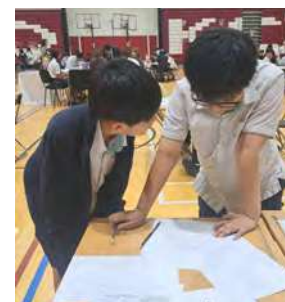

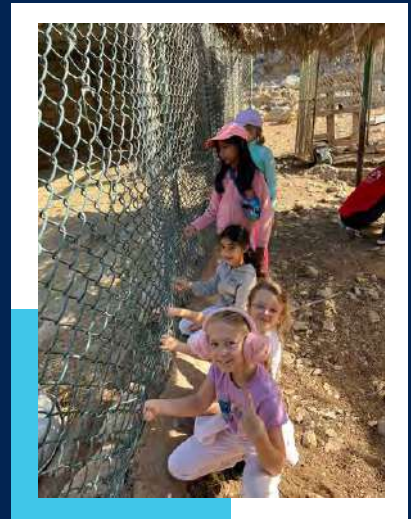

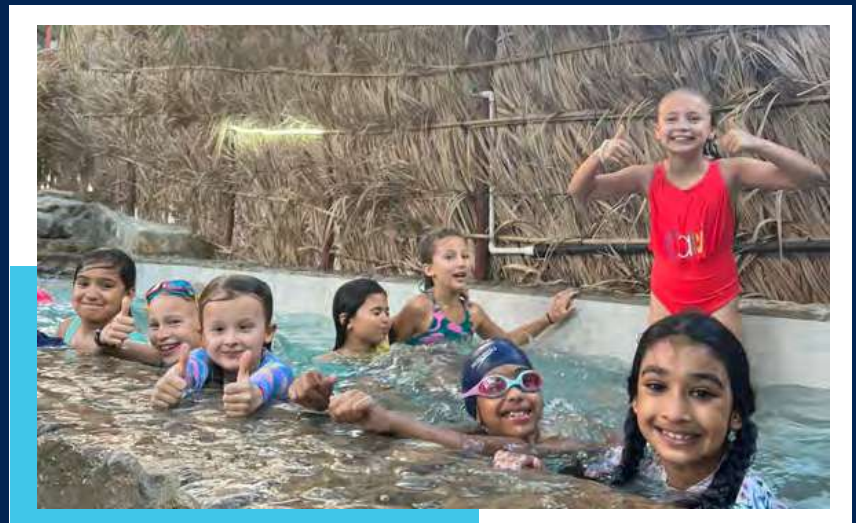
# Residential Trips: Years 3 and 4 Ras al Khaimah
